The Seed Intern 2 is responsible for harvesting, processing, and saving the Indigenous seed collection at Dream of Wild Health under the direction of the Seed Regeneration Supervisor. The position includes daily oversight of these crops within the context of the 2020 Farm Budget and Social Enterprise Plan.

## **Responsibilities & Expectations:**

## Farm Operations:

- Duties include weeding, mulching, watering, harvesting, processing, corn braiding and other duties pertaining to seed saving and fall clean up
- Complete concise written documentation and record keeping of observations and data of the saved seed collection.
- Assist with group tours and events related to seed saving projects as needed
- If time permits and schedule allows, general farm work as needed

## **Requirements:**

- Familiarity with Native community and culture strongly encouraged
- Demonstrate a strong work ethic
- Reliable transportation to and from farm in Hugo, MN
- Ability to lift up to 50 pounds
- Tolerance for heat and a positive attitude
- Willingness to learn and experience/interest in sustainable/organic farming
- Must follow directions well and be adaptable
- Experience using Excel spreadsheets and/or similar software. Ensure data collection is comprehensive. Contribute to the annual seed harvest report at close of season.

Must have flexibility to work occasional evenings and weekends. Must pass a criminal background check.
