The Youth Kitchen Intern will assist the nutrition staff, Chef and program staff in the day to day operations of our summer youth programs including meal preparation, cooking, set-up/clean-up, serving and working with youth participants.

Qualifications:

- Preferred candidates have completed at least one Dream of Wild Health Garden Warriors program session and are between the ages of 16 and 20 during summer programs.
- Willingness to learn, participate and take the lead in the tasks and responsibilities
- Good communication skills
- Ability to take initiative and get things done independently and within a team
- Ability to adapt and keep up in a fast paced intergenerational work environment
- Ability to delegate, lead by example, and get youth to participate

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Communicate regularly with Nutrition Program Coordinator and other DWH Staff
- Build relationships with and engage youth participants
- Keep an eye on everyone, make sure everyone is comfortable and involved in activities
- Adhere to and enforce the DWH Healthy Food Policy and Good Relative Policy when at the farm
- Work with DWH Program Team to identify and plan one 30-minute activity to <u>lead</u> for each youth program session (Cora's Kids 1, Cora's Kids 2, Garden Warriors 1, Garden Warriors 2)
- (Pending COVID restrictions) Assist with Garden Warriors Session 1 & 2 Feast Day preparations
- Attend at least one program staff meeting on Fridays during summer programs
- Attend Youth Kitchen Intern training for a day during the month of May
- Follow all Safety Policies & Procedures
- Assist with other farm and program duties as needed

Having transportation to and from the farm is a plus but is not required.
